ЗАДАНИЕ 8 The diagram shows the result of a research which goal was to find out what pieces of classical music people recognize.

According to the diagram, the most easily-recognizable melody is "Für Elise". "Ode to Joy" turned out to be the second best-known melody. The amount of people that recognized it is just 6 percents less than the amount of people that are familiar with "Für Elise". But the most surprising fact in my opinion is that only four percents of the respondents could recognize such a popular melody as "Flight of the Bumblebee".



ЗАДАНИЕ 8

A survey in Zealand revealed interesting insights about the recognition of classical music pieces. With "Für Elise" recognized by 36% and "Ode to Joy" by 30% of respondents, while "Wedding march" enjoyed a significant 28% recognition rate, it lagged slightly behind "Ode to Joy".

I think the data suggest that, while ⁵⁰ some classical pieces are ~~well~~ well-known, a lack of familiarity exists with others, even those frequently used in popular contexts like weddings.

Despite the enduring nature of classical music, it tends to be less appreciated by teenagers, which may hinder their emotional development. This issue could be addressed by implementing ¹⁰⁰ mandatory music classes in high schools and creating television advertisements featuring celebrities enjoying classical music. Such initiatives would inspire younger audiences to develop an appreciation for it.

In summary, I believe that listening to classical music is crucial due to its soothing effects, which can alleviate anxiety and assist ¹⁵⁰ individuals in managing stress. By fostering an appreciation for classical music, especially among younger generation development and overall well-being. Initiatives like mandatory music classes and engaging advertising campaigns could bridge the gap between classical music and today's youth encouraging them to explore its rich heritage.
